

JEAN-HENRI RIESENER

(, 1734 - , 1806)

RARE WRITING TABLE



Paris, Louis XVI period, 18th century

Mahogany, mottled mahogany veneered, black gilded leather and gilded bronze

Stamped by : J.H RIESENER, master in 1768

Rare rectangular table of Louis XVI period in mahogany and speckled mahogany veneer. It opens on the front with a writing-slide with black gilded leather, two drawers including one with compartments and a side drawer containing the writing kit. This piece of furniture rests on four straight feet decorated with casters, joined by a shelf which is topped by a gilded bronze cornice, like the one that covers the tray in marble white veined grey. Our table is enriched by a light ornamentation of gilt bronzes as laurel garlands and patterns of cut leather.
